



NORFOLK BEEKEEPERS' ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION 2017

Membership is open to anyone keeping bees or who has an interest in the craft of beekeeping. Full membership of NBKA gives automatic membership of the British Beekeepers' Association (BBKA). The annual subscription is payable in advance and runs from January 1st to December 31st. Members who have not paid their annual subscription by **31st March** will be considered to have left the Association. (Rule 27)

Full BBKA membership benefits include – information and advice on beekeeping, public and products liability insurance for members, the BBKA News and Brood Diseases insurance through BDI Ltd.

Membership Categories – A summary of categories is as follows:

- **Full Membership** – for those who keep bees and wish to benefit from BBKA membership and insurances.
- **Junior Membership** – for those under 18 years of age as at 1 January.
- **Social Membership** - for those who do not have bees and therefore have no need of BBKA or BDI insurance. Social membership is membership of NBKA only and does not confer membership of the BBKA or BDI insurance, nor does it confer entitlement to vote at the NBKA annual General Meeting (Rule 23).

Bee Disease Insurance

Full members only, covers losses due to notifiable diseases. Insurance for 3 hives is included with your subscription. **All** colonies must be insured. A colony is defined as any hive (including Apidea or similar hive) containing bees regardless of colony size. Extra premiums are required for **all** colonies as indicated overleaf. You will be covered for the whole of the year provided that payment is received prior to 31st March.

N.B. Where premiums are not paid by 31st March, cover does not commence until 40 days have elapsed following payment.

The 3 hive £2.00 premium indicated in the subscription for full membership must be paid, even if bees are not kept.

Privacy.

Personal data will be held on a computer. The data supplied by you will only be used for the purpose of administration of Norfolk Beekeepers' Association. We include in this definition contact with BBKA and the Bee Disease Inspectors as required.
